




## Head Teacher's Commendations

	<p>Silver commendations are awarded for:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• an individual piece of work or consistently commendable effort/work, as recommended by the class teacher;</li> <li>• a contribution to an assembly or other activity which is deemed worthy of commendation;</li> <li>• high achievement in a full or interim report, either through positive comments and/or where projected grades in most subjects equal or exceed the target grades.</li> </ul>
	<p>Green 'Target' commendations are awarded where all of the projected grades on a full or interim report are equal to or above the target grades.</p>
	<p>Red '100% Attendance' commendations are awarded when 100% attendance is recorded on a full or interim report.</p>

Head Teacher Commendations which are attached to full or interim reports are:

- recorded centrally and not transferred to students' planners. Credit will be given for these in the counts for House Awards. They can also be seen by parents when accessing assessment and behaviour records on-line;
- do not count towards the Making a Positive Contribution Award system which focuses on high quality individual pieces of work, the demonstration of outstanding effort or a positive contribution to the life of the school.
