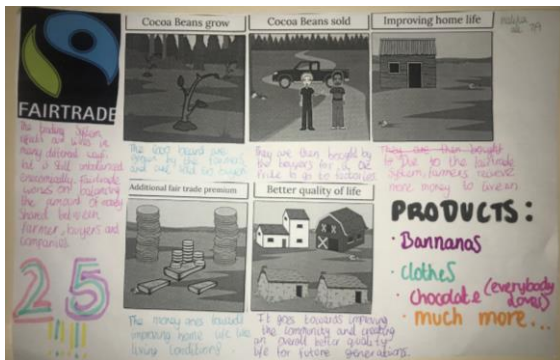
Seasons Greetings!
